What do we do at Hampshire Junior Club?

The club meets once a week to access activities in the community and social clubs as well as structured sessions in outdoor pursuits, cookery, sports and the arts.

Attending our sessions

We support children aged 5 to 12 years of age, with physical and/or mild-moderate learning difficulties or special education needs (SEN) in the South-East Hampshire region; including Emsworth, Havant, Hayling Island, Waterlooville, Fareham, Gosport and surrounding districts. Each member is supported in their own way, dependent on their specific disability and needs, to fully access and benefit from the session. A home-visit will need to take place to assess suitability and write a care plan.



About our staff

All our staff are enthusiastic, friendly, and trained to support young people, and all will have an enhanced Disclosure and Barring Service check. This means that families and carers can be confident in leaving their children with us whilst they can benefit from some much-needed respite.

Activities

Our activities are wide and varied at different locations and include social club, swimming, Playzone, cinema, cookery, art workshops, archery, chocolate making, horse riding, picnics, kayaking, rock climbing, sailing, lazer-quest, and theatre trips.

We also run day trips further afield to places such as Chessington Zoo, Winchester Science Museum and Birdworld.

When and where

Activities take place throughout the year on a weekly basis, usually on Sundays, in the Portsmouth, Havant, and Fareham area.

There is no obligation to attend all activities; parents and carers are free to register their young person for as many sessions as they please. Times vary dependent on the activity.

A minibus service supports the longer distance trips for which there may be a small charge.
